Safety protocols and protective measures

Long-term care is a highly controlled environment with strict infection control. We are committed to creating a safe workplace for you. Every home follows infection management and control protocols approved by public health and the Ministry of Long-Term Care.

All staff in long-term care wear surgical masks for their protection. As needed, staff also wear additional personal protective equipment such as gloves, gowns, face shields, and N95 masks.

All staff and residents are screened twice a day for symptoms and visitors are restricted to reduce the risk of infection.

All staff receive training in Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC).

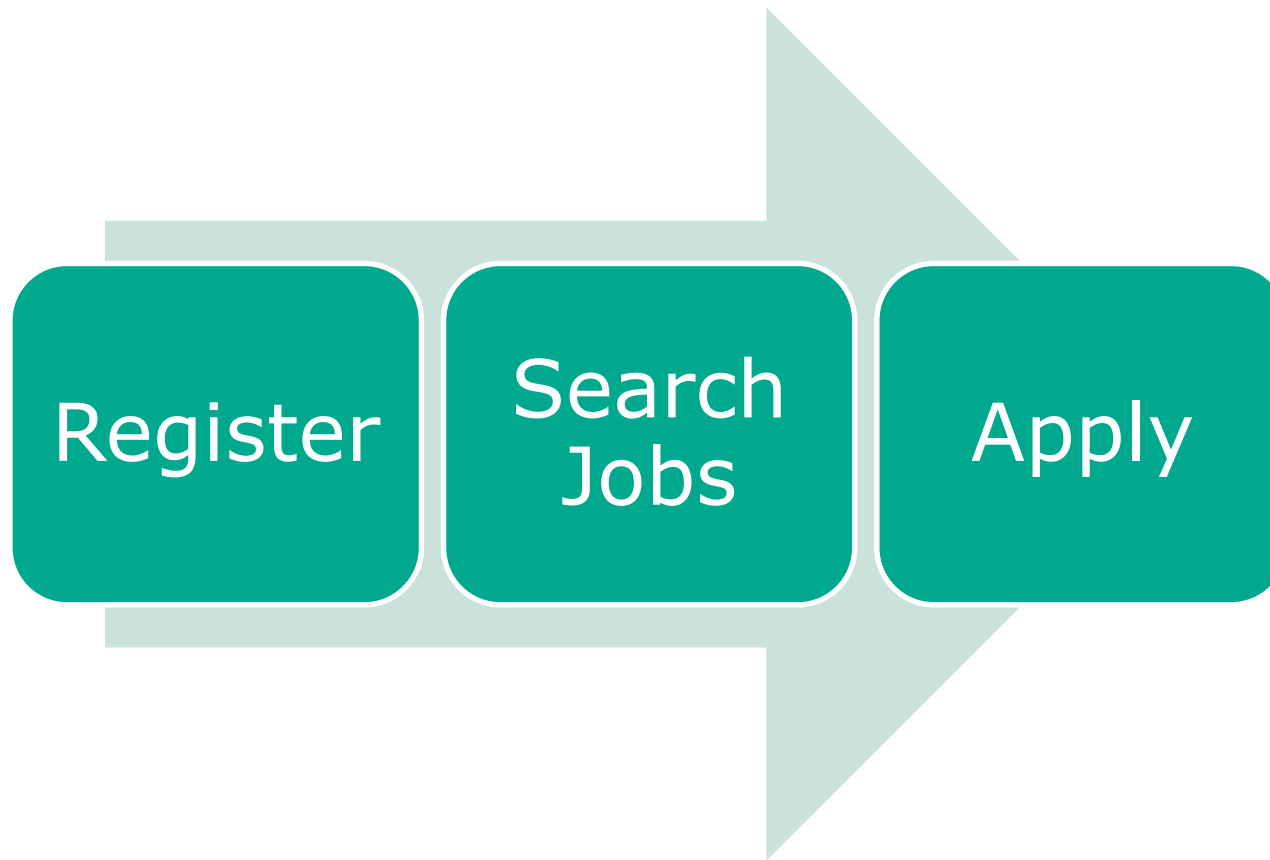

Step 1: Register as an applicant on Link2LTC

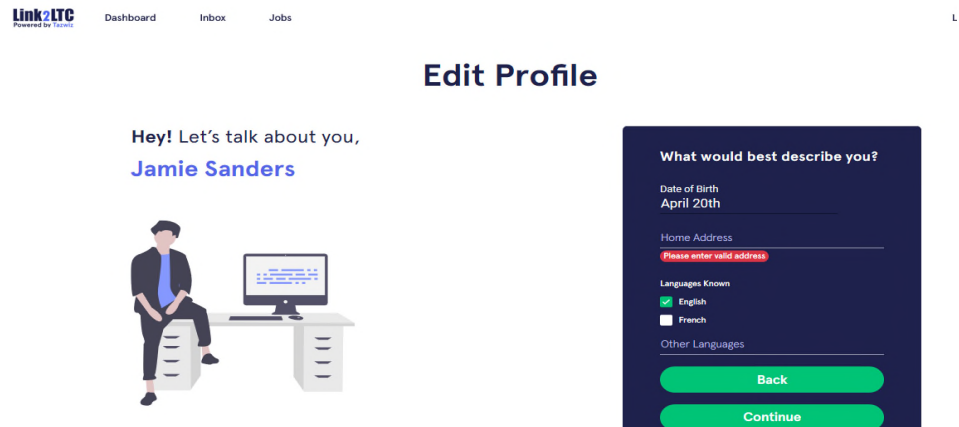
Set up an account at <https://ltc.tazwiz.com/register>

Are you a student? Apply with documents including your resume, cover letter, and relevant certifications.

If you're not a student, you can apply with documents such as a resume and cover letter, and you'll also be asked questions about your past experience and qualifications. Two references are required.

Get started and update later

Applicants can edit their profiles at any time with updated information and/or documents.



Steps 2 & 3 : Search and apply for jobs

Once a profile is created, you can begin applying for jobs right away through your profile dashboard by clicking the “jobs” button at the top of your screen.

Select jobs of interest to read the description and view where the home is located. Some job postings will list multiple locations to select from.

To apply, select the “apply for this job” button.

LTC homes that receive applications will reach out via the Link2LTC chat box function (inbox). The chat box is used to ask questions and set up an interview time.
